Heritage Plastics Products and LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design)

To Whom It May Concern:

Heritage Plastics Rigid nonmetallic PVC conduit contains at least 10% (ten per cent) by weight of recycled PVC plastic. As such, Heritage Plastics Schedule 40 and Schedule 80 rigid nonmetallic PVC meet MR4.1/4.2 Recycled Content requirements of LEED.

Heritage Plastics products manufactured within 500 miles of a particular project will meet MR5.1/5.2 provided the job location is within 500 miles of Carrollton, Ohio; Tampa, Florida; Weatherford, Texas; or Milford, Utah.

Heritage Plastics PVC Glue and cements do not meet the requirements of LEED EQ4.1 (Low-Emitting Materials (Adhesives & Sealants)).

Installation, field bending and heating does not affect the LEEDS program in any manner.
